Then work together with your teammates to escape before time runs out. People love escape rooms and it'll give you a chance to show off your critical thinking skills.

An escape room party is perfect for groups of 8 people or more. Invite families, couples, or a group of friends who are ready to be mentally challenged as they work together to solve a puzzle. If you have more than 8 people, you can book multiple rooms that all start at the same time. Also consider giving your guests a sleuth themed goodie bag (a nice reminder that you're always looking out for them). TIMING You can host an escape room party anytime. However, you might want to consider the month of September in honor of National Preparedness Month. VENUE There are thousands of escape rooms worldwide. Check your local listings to find one in your city.

Organization is the key to any successful event. Accomplish your mission by staying on track.

When you book your escape room, inquire about on-site food and beverage and the ability to bring in your own. Incorporating a meet and greet happy hour is a great way for you to connect with your guests before the event begins. It's especially important if you divide up into different rooms. The following are some fun food and drink ideas you might want to consider.

GOOD VIBES ONLY -

Icebreaker

Get everyone in the proper mindset of solving a mystery by playing a game of "Guess Who" during your happy hour. This is a great way for guests to bond before they start their adventure. Place a sticky note on their back with the name of a famous person. Tell them to walk around the room and ask others yes and no answers about who they are until they guess their correct name.

Music

Playing music in the background adds a festive vibe to any party. Consider creating a playlist ahead of time with songs like "Magical Mystery Tour." Be sure to keep the volume at a reasonable level so people can hear each other.
