-WHO TO INVITE -

- TIMING -

You can host a happy hour any time of the year. We recommend planning one between 4-7 pm on a weeknight during the spring or Summer. Make it casual to allow people to stop by any time to say hello.

VENUE —

Find a local hot spot to host your happy hour. If possible, find a place where you can reserve a private area, or sit on a patio and listen to live music.

It's always good to have a plan for your event. Fortunately, this party is simple and requires little effort on your part.

Food & Drink

This is the easiest party when it comes to food and drink. Your restaurant partner will do it all. Just pick the appetizers, provide drink tickets and you're all set.

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GOOD VIBES ONLY -

Icebreaker

This will be a casual party where people are likely to come and go. Encourage conversation among your guests by asking them to write an answer to an icebreaker question on their name tag. For example, if you have a tropical themed happy hour, ask "If you're going to sail around the world, what's the name of your boat?"

Music

Playing music in the background adds a festive vibe to any party. Consider creating a friendly and upbeat playlist ahead of time with music you think your guests will enjoy or find a Pandora station to play in the background. Be sure to keep the volume at a reasonable level so people can hear each other.
